Since 1978, Bobbie has been the owner of and instructor at Eugene Obedience Training in Eugene, Oregon, where she teaches all levels of competition obedience. Her positive approach and attention to the dog/trainer relationship produces enthusiastic dogs and handlers that are eager to learn and work. It is this unique, relationship-based approach that lends such success to Bobbie and her students.

Bobbie's training style is fast-paced and exciting for both the dog and handler, making obedience FUN for the dog, trainer and spectator! Bobbie believes that learning about dog training is a hands-on experience.

This is a highly motivational working obedience seminar. Seminar participants are encouraged to bring a dog on both Saturday and Sunday. Saturday will begin with Bobbie's training philosophy and foundation skills and will progress through every obedience exercise. There will be activities on both days appropriate for dogs of all levels.
